GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- **ALL PARENTS SHOULD**
- Intimate the school of any change in address and telephone number (s) through the student's almanac as they are vital in the interest of the safety of the students.
- Ensure that sufficient time is spent with their wards daily to ensure a good level of understanding
- Check the almanac regularly and note that all circulars are accessed on the website and parent portal.
- Sign all the notes sent by the school regularly in the almanac and ensure that the child shows the almanac to the teacher.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

EACH STUDENT MUST

- Mark their belongings for easy identification.
- Care for the personal appearance & maintain their uniform in a neat and clean condition.
- Keep the school neat, tidy and take care of school property .
- Show respect and courtesy to everyone.
- Be punctual and come to school on time.
- Carry the identification cards provided by the school & show them whenever they leave the school campus. The loss of the card should be immediately reported to the school authority.
- Carry the almanac to the school every day and use it for communication between parents and school.

ATTENDANCE RULES

Neoteric World School believes regular attendance is essential to the progress & achievement of the student. Any student absence will need to be accompanied by a satisfactory explanation provided by the parent, given either through a written note in the almanac, an application or through e-mail to the school.

- Parents of students who plan to miss school for more than 3 days are required to notify the teachers and the office at least ten (10) days before the anticipated absence. They must get written approval from the Principal.
- Attendance is monitored and recorded daily.
- If a student is absent for 3 or more days due to illness, a medical certificate should be attached with the application informing the class teacher and Principal. Pupils suffering from contagious diseases like chicken pox, mumps, measles or influenza are not allowed to attend school till the quarantine period is over. A fitness certificate from a medical practitioner must be submitted on the pupil's return.
- A written note through the school almanac and/ or email should be sent to the class teacher and Principal for any special permission like exemption from sports / any other activity for a few days with valid reasons
- It is the responsibility of the student to make up for the work missed during leave periods. School staff will provide support as needed.

SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES

- Students must wear their uniforms with pride and ensure that they look neat & presentable at all times. I-Cards are an integral part of school's uniform.
- A student must always come to school in uniform. There is no exemption for practical and special classes.
- No student is allowed to attend any Open House/PTM, school function in or outside the school in any dress other than school uniform.
- No jewellery or fancy watches are allowed to be worn in school.
- Nails should be cut short.
- Only small inexpensive stud / loops earrings are permitted for girls in school.
- Regular haircuts for boys. No mushroom / crew cut / streaked /spiked or gelled hair is permitted in school.
- Casual dress is permitted only on birthdays.
